The Y's Everett Teen Enrichment Center is a drop-in center that gives the teens a safe place to go in the afternoon. ETEC helps teen realize who they are and what they can achieve through caring staff, positive mentoring and enrichment programming. The ETEC is open to Everett Teens between the ages 12-18 years old. Membership is required. Some of the features of the Everett Teen Enrichment Center include:

- Computer Lab with 10 computers and supervised internet access.
- Basketball with 2 hours of access to indoor, air-conditioned court.
- School year leadership, arts & music, academic, health & wellness, college exploration and volunteer programming.
- Free lunch and snack during summer and dinner during school year.

EVERETT TEEN ENRICHMENT CENTER PROGRAMS

In partnership with Mayor Carlo DiMaria, the Y's Everett Teen Enrichment Center is a drop-in center open year round that gives the teens a safe, substance free place to go. At the Y, we help build a healthy spirit, mind and body for all with the core values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility at the heart of everything we do. The Everett Teen Enrichment Center helps teens realize who they are and what they can achieve through caring staff, positive mentoring and enrichment programming. In addition to a drop-in center, ETEC offers teens structured programming in the areas of leadership, education, workforce development and the arts during the school year. ETEC is open to all Everett teens between the ages 12-18 years old. Membership is required and is \$10 per teen for the year. Scholarships are available. All programs are free with ETEC membership. Below are a list of the current program offerings.

ACHIEVERS PROGRAM: This program is for High school Juniors & Seniors that provides education and support to teens and their families in preparing for the successful transition from high school. Through program participation, teens will learn how to set post-graduation goals and will receive direction and support in order to meet those goals. Teens meet three times a week to explore career pathways, learn life skills, navigate college application and financial aid process, tour local colleges, receive homework & project support, fundraise, job shadow, perform community service, etc. The end of the year goal is for teens to experience 1 week out of state tour of colleges during April vacation.

JR. ACHIEVERS PROGRAM: Offered to High school Freshmen & Sophomores where they will receive the support and guidance to stay on track in high school. Teens will have the opportunity to develop skills needed to be accepted into college and excel in college, have the knowledge to research for college and complete college admission process, explore different career clusters and make a plan for the future. This group meets three times a week and will participate in fundraising, community service, college tours. Homework and project support is also provided. The end of the year goal is for teens to experience 1 week out of state tour of colleges during April vacation.

LEADERS CLUB: This program is for high school teens and offers extensive leadership training and offers opportunities for service to their YMCA and community. This program meets twice a week and helps youth explore their interests and learn outside the classroom. Teens will identify issues within their community create a project to affect change. Once a month, teens will perform a community service or service learning project followed by a reflection session.

Y LEAD: This program is for middle school students and teaches youth how to become contributors to their community, why they should want to give back to their community, how to give back through service projects they select, organize, and implement. Youth meet twice a week and should be enthusiastic, caring, honest, respectful, responsible, positive attitude, dependable and hard-working.

YOUTH IN GOVERNMENT: Offered at the Malden Y Teen Center. The YMCA Youth in Government motto is Democracy must be learned by each generation. Every person can make a difference. Y&G helps participants acquire the following skills to take into the future: Public speaking/ communications, greater understanding of democratic process, enhanced leadership skills, application of moral and ethical values to life decisions. Y&G focuses on: the core values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility, civic engagement, fun.

TEEN CENTER COMMITTEE: Teens meet with ETEC management and community to discuss issues relating to the Teen Center and community. The teen committee members will plan activities, fieldtrips, guest speakers, new programs, and community service projects for the Teen Center. Teens will decide on all fundraising opportunities and support management efforts to promote the Teen Center through social and print media. Limited participation available. Must complete application and interview process for consideration.
